

Seaside Park Landfill Rehabilitation

The challenge of the Brady Road landfill closure project was to arrive at a solution that met client requirements and also satisfied community and stakeholder expectations, mindful at the outset that the site was a disused landfill with approximately 50 percent of the area having little or no landfill cover.

The result of the rehabilitation project - the Seaside Park complex, displays a range of innovative features covering landscaping and land use concepts, design, and construction practices.

In terms of physical size, cost and the duration of rehabilitation works, it is the largest project of its kind undertaken by Auckland City, and is the largest municipal landfill rehabilitation project ever undertaken in New Zealand.
